I. RECYCLABLES

PAPERS

PLASTIC

Example :
Plastic Food Containers /
Containers / Plastic Bags /
Plastic Bottles / Plastic
Plastic Buckets



GLASS

Example :
Ketchup Bottles /
Drinking Bottles



CAN/METAL

Example :
Aluminium Cans /
Food Cans / Iron / Metal



2. GENERAL WASTE

LEFTOVERS

Example :
Fruit Peels /
Vegetables /
Eggshells / Rice



DIRTY WASTE

Example :
Disposable Diapers / Dirty Tissues / Dirty
Materials / Contaminated Papers or Boxes



TIPS

- Please tie up your old newspapers into tidy and organised bundles
- Rinse and dry your beverage containers, plastic containers, glass containers, or aluminium cans that contain waste
- The packaging for food and beverages with the  logo is recyclable
- You may also dispose your malfunctioned electrical appliances to recycling centres which collect electronic waste
